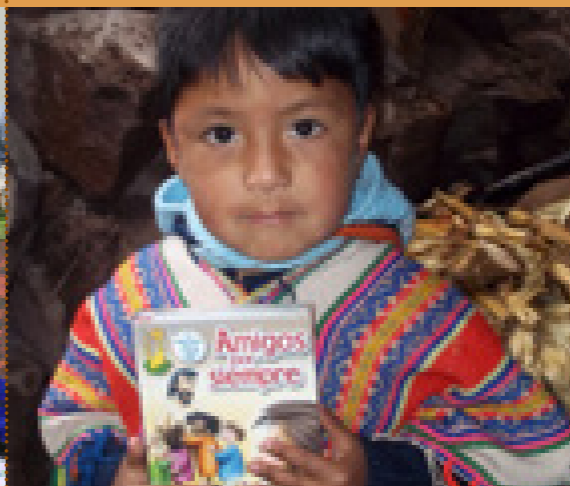

Translation still needed

The Bible Society in Papua New Guinea is involved in 22 different translation projects! 14 of these are partnerships with other agencies and 8 are exclusively run by the Bible Society.

Translation teams are often small, isolated groups of local people, filled with a dream for their own community to have the Bible. With over 800 languages in Papua New Guinea, they need help and prayer for this task.

You can help translate a verse this Christmas.

Braille Bibles

It is an awful truth that many people from Uganda are shunned and hidden away, simply because they are blind. Yet God offers acceptance and abundant life.

The Bible Society in Uganda is determined to place braille Scripture where all can access it – from schools to churches, from libraries to individual homes. However, with a complete Bible needing 43 volumes at a cost of around £400, this is no easy task!

Will you put the Bible at people's fingertips?

£10 places a book of the 4 Gospels in braille.

Faith Comes by Hearing

Not all Bibles look the same. For people who cannot see, or have never learned to read, a Bible they can hear is often what they need. The Bible Society in Togo is helping set up Bible Listening groups in prisons, schools and churches.

People are gathering in unexpected places to hear what God's Word speaks into their lives. Wind-up audio Bibles called 'Proclaimers' are making a world of difference in Togo!

Will you send the Bible to a listening group?

£18 covers the cost of a 'Proclaimer' Bible for Togo.

Bible Storytelling

Large numbers of migrants arrive in the Gulf States seeking work. Many are vulnerable to forced labour, exploitation or trafficking. The Bible Society in the Gulf, along with churches and other organisations, recognised the opportunity to bring help and truth to these desperate workers.

As many cannot read the Bible for themselves, Bible storytelling has been making a huge impact. Many are turning to Christ and sharing the story with family and friends.

You can spread the story of the Gospel to people far from home.

£26 brings God's message to 10 migrant workers.

Bread of Life

For over 15 years, the Bread of Life Programme has been providing children in Peru with breakfasts and Bibles. The Bible Society in Peru partner with local churches to impact children living in poverty.

Many of their mothers are drawn into God's presence also as they are encouraged to volunteer along with church members to make the breakfast. Lives are being changed every day.

You can help share the Bread of Life this Christmas.

£30 covers the full cost of feeding and teaching 1 child for 3 months.

People on the edge

There are people living on the edge of society in Cambodia for different reasons. Some are in isolated rural villages, some are in prison, others are battling poverty etc.

Despite the reason, there are many who have no access to the Bible. The Bible Society in Cambodia is working to change this – travelling thousands of miles every year to deliver Scripture and set up literacy classes which impact people of all ages.
